TOOLS FOR VOLUNTEERS

RISC: Railroad Investigation & Safety Course

RISC formerly known as GCCI (Grade Crossing Collison Investigation Course) is back. This course provides critical information allowing first responders to respond to respond to and investigate incidents involving the railroad effectively and safely.

RISC is offered in three levels: Basic (1-hour), Intermediate (2-hours), and Advanced (4-hours). Training is available at no cost to help officers and first responders more effectively and safely manage incidents.

Kansas Operation Lifesaver is now offering the Railroad Investigation and Safety Course (RISC). Up to 4 hours of free training is offered on the topic of how to work railroad incidents. This includes collisions with motor vehicles, pedestrians, other trains, derailments, and working incidents near or on railroad property. For brochure <u>click here</u>.


